STUDIO POLICY

TIME: Lessons will be either thirty minutes or one hour in length, and occur once per week unless arranged otherwise. Each student has a reserved lesson time, and is responsible for that time. Lesson time cannot be extended due to late arrival.

SCHEDULING: Lesson schedules are reworked three times per year: at the beginning of each school semester (January and August) and at the beginning of summer (June). If you need to change your lesson time at a different point, please let me know and we will try to find another time. Students may elect to continue lessons during the summer, or take summer off and resume in the fall. In the event that I will be traveling for research, performances, or vacation, I will give advance notice.

CANCELLATIONS: Lessons canceled with at least twenty-four hours advance notice or due to emergencies/illness will be rescheduled or credited for the following month. Students are responsible to pay for lessons canceled less than twenty-four hours in advance. No refunds will be given for no-shows or tardiness. If I must cancel for any reason, lessons will be rescheduled or credited.

FEES: As of January 2023, lesson rates are as follows:

\$35 per 30-minute lesson

\$70 per 60-minute lesson

These rates do not include materials (lesson books, etc.), competitions/festivals, exams, etc.

PAYMENT: Lessons will be billed on a monthly basis. Payment for the month is due on the first lesson date of each month. Please make checks payable to Heather Moore.

MATERIALS: Students should have a piano/keyboard at home so that they can practice during the week. Practice is a very important part of piano lessons! Students are also responsible for purchasing materials (lesson books, etc.) that will be used during our lessons.

CONDUCT: Students are asked to refrain from eating, drinking (water is OK!), chewing gum, or using electronic devices during the lesson. This will ensure that we have a fun and productive learning environment. © Parents are welcome to sit in on lessons if desired.
